We also provide sector specific language training that can help remove barriers to employment, and lead to a more secure future. Clients are accompanied on their journey to employment through participation in a variety of job search preparation activities.

What do newcomers gain by participating in the program?

- Personalized support to identify goals and create an action plan to improve workplace language skills and secure employment.
- Access to employment counselling and ongoing support to overcome barriers to employment.
- Opportunities to participate in job-readiness workshops where you will:
 - develop the skills and confidence to conduct your job search;
 - gain a better understanding of the Canadian workplace;
 - develop a Canadian-style resume;
 - enhance your interview skills.
- Connections to employers through networking events, employer referrals, and job matching activities.
- Access to enhanced workplace language and communication skills courses including On-The-Job Language Training for various occupations.
- Referrals to other services, such as language and computer courses, with World Skills or other community organizations.

The Roadmap to Employment program is for someone who:

- has a Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) level 3-5;
- is a resident of Ontario;
- is a Permanent Resident, Convention Refugee or Live-in Caregiver, and;
- is legally permitted to work in Canada.
